<p>Language Arts (Mrs. Becke)</p>	<p>We will be continuing our new theme on Mythology this week. Reading, writing and grammar activities around this theme for the next three months. Our final project for this unit is on our class website and will be due on <i>Friday March 9</i> and will be done at home.</p> <p><i>Writing</i> Students will begin the week by writing a journal about the least scary monster in history. They will be working on SB Editing, Language Power Now, Correct the Sentence, Canada Writes and cursive writing. We will be doing short poems and other writing activities going along with our Mythology theme.</p> <p><i>Grammar</i> In grammar this week, students will focus on simple and complex verbs.</p> <p><i>Reading</i> Students will be working on reading comprehension based on stories, articles and more read independently, in small groups, or as a class. These pieces will be focused around our Mythology theme. Students will begin working through their Ontario Reading books. We will continue our class read aloud novel, <u>Harry Potter & The Philosopher's Stone</u>, by J.K. Rowling.</p> <p><i>Spelling</i> There are a number of spelling lists currently in circulation in order to give each child the best chance to succeed and be challenged in an appropriate way. If you would like me to send you your child's list and the "rule" that the words follow, please email me! <i>Spelling tests will take place on Friday March 2.</i></p>
<p>Math (Mrs. Becke)</p>	<p>Students will be working on the Saxon Math program lessons 91-94, which will include: We will do a math investigation on Friday and Mathletics on Thursday. <i>Math Assessment #17 will take place on Monday February 26 2018.</i></p>
<p>Science (Mrs. Becke)</p>	<p>We will be continuing our unit on plants this week. We will be studying pollination and how plants affect our lives.</p>
<p>Social Studies (Mrs. Becke)</p>	<p>We will be starting our new unit on Living & Working in Canada this week. We will begin with a scavenger hunt about Ontario and will write short paragraphs about the city we live in (I am anticipating lots of Burlingtons!)</p>

French (Mr. Rodayan)	Students will review sight words and common expressions to help build on their understanding of French conversation prompts. They will continue with their vocabulary words to prepare for a “dictée” this week.

Computers (Mr. Kudera)	The students will complete their Countdown PowerPoint presentation.
Visual Art (Mrs. Becke)	We will continue to learn about perspective art and landscapes. We will be using lines to create these pieces.
Drama (Mrs. Becke)	We will continue our unit on Characterization and begin practicing our short plays.
