<p>Language Arts (Mrs. Becke)</p>	<p>We will be beginning our new theme on Mythology this week. Reading, writing and grammar activities around this theme for the next three months. Our final project for this unit will be posted on the class website and will be sent home with students on January 15.</p> <p><i>Writing</i> Students will begin the week by writing a journal about the least scary monster in history. They will be working on SB Editing, Language Power Now, Correct the Sentence, Canada Writes and cursive writing. We will begin our new study and project on a “monster” of the world. Eventually, all of our chapters will be compiled into a textbook for our school library.</p> <p><i>Reading</i> Students will be working on reading comprehension based on stories, articles and more read independently, in small groups, or as a class. These pieces will be focused around our Mythology theme. Students will begin working through their Ontario Reading books. We will begin our class read aloud novel, <u>Harry Potter & The Philosopher’s Stone</u>, by J.K. Rowling.</p> <p>This week, we will also begin our novel study on <u>The Lion, The Witch & The Wardrobe</u> by C.S. Lewis. Novel study work will be done at school with the exception of some activities.</p> <p><i>Spelling</i> There are a number of spelling lists currently in circulation in order to give each child the best chance to succeed and be challenged in an appropriate way. If you would like me to send you your child’s list and the “rule” that the words follow, please email me! <i>Spelling tests will take place on Friday January 26th.</i></p>
<p>Math (Mrs. Becke)</p>	<p>Students will be working on the Saxon Math program lessons 71-15, which will include: We will do a math investigation on Friday and Mathletics on Thursday. <i>Math Assessment #14 will take place on Monday January 29.</i></p>
<p>Science (Mrs. Becke)</p>	<p>We will be doing review for our Structures test, which will take place on <i>Thursday January 25 2018.</i></p>

Social Studies (Mrs. Becke)	We will be learning about how early settler children lived and how it compares to how we live now. We will be reading though journal entries of Early Settler children as well as creating venn diagrams to explain our thoughts.
