## EXTENSION ACTIVITIES

1. Research: Who is Roberta Bondar? Why would a school be named after her? What is the connection between Roberta Bondar and the content of this novel?
2. Interview the oldest member of your family. Write down your questions and their answers. Ask questions to find out about your family's history.
3. Create an anti-bullying poster for your school. Your poster should explain why bullying is wrong and what you should do if you are being bullied.
4. Draw a picture of Roli & Oli based on the description on page 58.
5. Create a diorama depicting the Meono Village as described on pages 76-77.
6. Research a lunar eclipse. Explain what happens during a lunar eclipse and find out how often they occur.
7. Draw a picture of the Evil Shadow Creatures.
8. Using the descriptions in Chapters 17 & 18, recreate the coded map that Jack found. Be sure to include a legend that translates what each of the symbols on the map means.
9. The symbol for the Meono tribe is a miniature lion. What symbol would you choose to represent your family? Draw your symbol and explain why you chose this symbol.
10. One of J.J. Price's students drew the cover for this story. Create a new title page for the story with pictures you think would help readers understand what the story is about.
