Summarizing Guide for Non-Fiction Articles

Tips:

•Be sure to select an article that makes sense to you.

•Read the article completely through as a preview read.

•Read the article a second time as a close read. This time, look for the main idea of the article and supporting details. Try highlighting keywords/phrases. •Read the article again if needed.

•Complete the organizer below.

•When you are ready to write your summary, try not to look back at the article too much. Write about the article from your own perspective. •Remember, your teacher wants to know what **you understand** about the article.

•Never copy the author's writing. The author's job is to inform you about a topic. Your job is to make sense of it.

•Include the main idea and important keywords/details.

•Don't add your opinions.
