Know terms of Ch. 4.1 – 4.4 (Egypt) and 7.1 – 7.3 (Hebrews) of the textbook. Be able to define and apply these terms

- **Know dates and details about the three major periods of Egyptian history:**
The Old Kingdom (2700 – 2200 BCE), The Middle Kingdom (2000 – 1800 BCE), and The New Kingdoms of Egypt (1600 – 1100 BCE).
- **Know details about king Narmer (aka Menes) and the three crowns of Egypt.**
- **Know details about the famous pharaohs of Egyptian history:**
Djoser (the step pyramid at Saqqara), Khufu (the Great Pyramid of Giza), Mentuhotep II (the Middle Kingdom), Ahmose, Hatshepsut, Akhenaton and Nefertiti, Tutankhamon (aka King Tut), and Ramses II (the Great).

- **Understand Egyptian religion**
