Directions:

- Ⓢ Label each item on the map.
- Ⓢ In order for a map to be most useful, it must be neat and easy to read. Neatness counts.
- Ⓢ Items under each category should be labeled the same way. For example, all states and territories should be all capital letters.
- Ⓢ Before labeling anything, plan out where each item goes. Certain items must go in a very spot, others can be located in a number of areas.
- Ⓢ Each state and territory must be colored (lightly) using colored pencil after all labeling is completed.
