

Santa Rosa Academy Acceptable Use Policy

Elementary Chromebook/MacBook Learning Program

In addition to the provisions of the Santa Rosa Academy Technology Acceptable Use Agreement (which was signed during enrollment or reenrollment), the following additional items apply to students and participating in the Elementary Chromebook/MacBook Learning Program:

- 1. As an educational tool students will use Chromebook/MacBook only for school-related purposes.
- 2. Students will keep their Chromebook/MacBook clean with no attached stickers or other items that might deface or damage the laptops finish, screen, or other components.
- 3. No attempt will be made without permission to load and use additional apps or games on the Chromebook/MacBook. No attempts will be made without school permission to modify or reconfigure the Chromebook/MacBook.
- 4. Students will only use their SRA-issued Google Apps for EDU account when operating the Chromebook/MacBook.
- 5. Students will immediately report all malfunction or damage of a Chromebook/MacBook to a classroom teacher or technology support staff member at their school.
- 6. Students will not disassemble or attempt to disassemble any part of their Chromebook/MacBook. Students will not attempt to physically repair the Chromebook/MacBook or to upgrade/install any additional internal hardware.
- 7. Students will not download or store inappropriate content on the Chromebook/MacBook.
- 8. Unless part of a school project and with the knowledge of a school staff member, students will not use email, instant messaging or log onto chat rooms or online forums during school hours.
