schedule-noun-a plan for carrying out a process or procedure, giving lists of intended events and times; an appendix to a formal document or statute, especially as a list, table or inventory.
adjective-arrange or plan (an event) to take place at a particular time.

contributes-verb-give something in order to help achieve or provide something; help to cause or bring about; supply (an article) for publication

development-noun-the process of developing or being developed; the process of starting to experience or suffer from an ailment or feeling.

plot-noun-a plan made in secret by a group of people to do something illegal or harmful; the main events of a play, novel, movie, or similar work, devised and presented by the writer as an interrelated sequence.

secret-adjective/noun-not known or seen or not meant to be known or seen by others.

concern-verb-worry; make anxious. noun-anxiety; worry; a matter of interest or importance to someone.

prevent-verb-keep something from happening or arising.

tension-noun-the state of being stretched tight; mental or emotional strain. verb-apply a force to something that tends to stretch it.

remarkable-adjective-worthy of attention; striking.

typically-generally or normally; in the usual way.
