Behavior Expectations:

- Students will be expected to:
 - Abide by the social contract that will be created with input from all students.
 - Pay attention! This can be demonstrated by taking notes and participating in class.
 - Try their best!
 - Work with other students in a cooperative and respectful manner.
 - Complete all assignments and to the best of their ability. This includes the monthly moral focus assignment.

Classroom Procedures:

- "Do Now" will be on the board each day. Come into class quietly and begin working.
- Homework will be corrected every day. After we check homework each day, it will either be turned in by you or checked in by me. Late homework will not be accepted. If you are absent, you have as many days as you were absent to hand in missed work.
 - Homework will be graded on how hard students try. Mistakes on homework are ok. Blank spaces or simply writing down the problem will not be accepted. Assignments will be given an incomplete if there is no work to back up student solutions, if the problem is blank or if the problem is simply rewritten.
 - Students with two or more missing or incomplete assignments (from any class) in a one week period will receive homework club for the following Thursday.

- You may use the restroom during the first five minutes of class and the last five minutes of class. You will not be able to leave the classroom during instruction. Please ask before leaving the classroom.
- If you are absent, homework will be listed on the whiteboards at the front of the class, as well as the calendar on the class webpage.
- Your math binder should be kept neat (no pages hanging out) and in order. You may use tabs to organize homework, notes, and tests and quizzes or you may use a chronological organization format. Choose the style of organization that works best for you.
 - If you need help with organization, please ask me for help!
