A leader communicates the vision, objectives, and goals of the organization. A leader motivates, supports, and organizes teams and groups; demonstrates initiative, open-mindedness, and (is) adaptable to new ideas; positive outlook, who mediates and integrates various groups and interests in the organization; systematically works towards achieving organizational goals.	Exemplary school leaders: somebody who inspires community members to work towards a common school goal. Characteristics: credibility, tenacity, path creator and influential.

A leader has a clear vision of the school now and in the future, and has the standards and expectations of their personnel for how to achieve them. A leader knows how to follow through with expectations and uses personal connections with staff to keep morale positive and staff motivated.	An exemplary school leader is a person with various personality and organizational qualities, who thinks beyond about the future and creates an image of what is expected from the school and then leads people to reach that goal using collaboration from its members.
