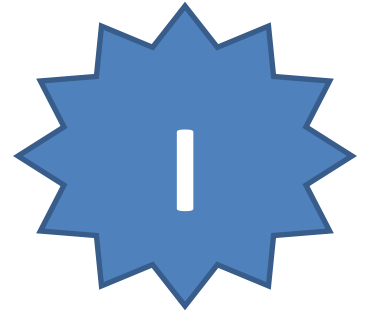

Job Description:

- Draw a picture of any scene from the selection that has not yet been illustrated, as if you were hired to illustrate the book. It can be a sketch, cartoon, diagram, or stick figure scene.
- Illustration is made on whole sheet of paper and uses color and details (no “white” left on page).
- On the backside of the picture, it includes the illustrator’s name, reading group, passage chosen, and the page on which it is found.

Presentation Plan: When the Discussion Leader invites you to participate, you may show your picture without commenting on it, and let the others in your group individually guess what your picture means. After everyone has had a turn to guess, it is your turn to tell them what your picture means, where it came from, or what it represents to you. You may make your picture on this sheet, or on a separate page.
