Content: Foundations of Algebra will provide many opportunities to revisit and expand the understanding of foundational algebra concepts, will employ diagnostic means to offer focused interventions, and will incorporate varied instructional strategies to prepare students for required high school mathematics courses. The course will emphasize both algebra and numeracy in a variety of contexts including number sense, proportional reasoning, quantitative reasoning with functions, and solving equations and inequalities.

Homework Make-Ups.

If a student was absent the day an assignment/homework was GIVEN they have **2 days** to turn it in. Meaning if a student was absent on Monday, when they return on Tuesday they will pick up the assignment and it will be due on Wednesday. When a student is absent it is his/her responsibility to pick up their missed materials from the absent folder in the class or print the assignment from the website if home access is available.

If a student was absent the day a homework was COLLECTED, they must turn it in the next day they are present in class. For example if a homework is due on Tuesday and the student was absent Tuesday, then it is due when they return on Wednesday.

Assessment Make-ups

If a student is absent the day before an assessment, the student is still responsible for taking the assessment on the assigned day as they have missed no new instruction because of the absence.

If a student is absent the day an assessment is given, the student is responsible for scheduling a make-up time with the teacher outside of normal class hours. Class time will not be given for making up an assessment. The student must schedule the make-up session within a week.

Missing assignment Policies

In Synergy if you see a grade with an A next to it, it means that the assignment is late and can be turned in based on the rules stated above. Any grade of 0 WITHOUT an A, means that the student earned a 0 on the assignment and it cannot be turned in.
